

Tutorial Benefits: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Visual instruction - Repetition - Asynchronous - Better use of librarian's time for synchronous sessions 	Tutorial Pitfalls: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Maintenance (general and interface changes) - Keeping track of authors/locations
Podcast benefits: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - repetition - increased "learner interaction - increased communication 	Podcast Pitfalls <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Creating/editing takes time - Keeping them manageable size/length - Troubleshooting user error
Blog benefits: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Subscription distribution - Timely but archive list - write/journal as part of e-portfolio - Comment/feedback 	Blog Pitfalls <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Creating/editing takes time - Writing timely and interesting - Spam
Wiki benefits: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Low Threshold Application - Collaborate - Comment feedback - Portfolio evaluation 	Wiki Pitfalls <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Creating/editing takes time - Vandalism
RSS benefits: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Podcasts, blogs and wikis - facilitates timely communication - "pre-feed" into courseware - subject page update 	RSS Pitfalls: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Variety of readers complicates the learning curve
Delicious & RefWorks benefits: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Web accessible - Allows "sharing" of resources - Increased communication - Citing Sources & Avoiding Plagiarism 	Delicious & RefWorks pitfalls <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - interoperability - RefWorks is proprietary - Potentially unwieldy
Skype benefits: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Low Threshold Application - Alternate in/formal channels - Voice/conference calls - History feature - Allows attachments 	Skype Pitfalls <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Unsolicited "callers"
